

I will be with you through the season of Lent, leaving you with glory of the resurrected Jesus. My last Sunday will be Easter Sunday.

I leave you with this prayer:

Almighty God, through your Son Jesus Christ, you watch over our going out and coming in: bless this time of ending and beginning. You surround your people in every time and place: keep us close in your love. You accompany your people in times of joy and times of trial: prosper all that has been done to your glory in this time together. The Lord bless you and keep you, the Lord face shine on you with grace and mercy, the Lord look upon you favor and give you peace. Amen.
